

The Bega Valley Mural Prize is a prize specifically for artists living and working in the Bega Valley Shire. An evolution of the BEGA ART PRIZE which has run in differing forms since 1992 with the support of the Bega Valley Shire Council.

The prize is open to artists working in all mediums, 2D, 3D, photographic etc, and will take the form of two artists' works being reproduced at large scale to be presented as public murals on BVSC water tanks in locations throughout the Shire. Two artists will be selected by a panel of judges to have their works displayed and each will win \$500. The two water tank locations for 2017 are Bermagui and Bemboka.

## Terms of Entry

1. Entries will be accepted from artists living within the Bega Valley Shire. The work must have been completed within the last 12 months and must be the original work of the exhibitor. Works are to be submitted as digital files and are open to artists working in any medium, 2D, 3D, photographic etc etc The reproduction of the work will be made into the mural.

2. Entry Fee is \$20 (\$15 for Friends of the BVRG). This fee is non-refundable.

3. Entry is via digital channels only. See <u>http://gallery.begavalley.nsw.gov.au</u> for entry details.

4. There is no limit to the number of entries an artist can submit, but a separate application form and entry fee must accompany each entry. Only one work per artist will be selected to be a mural.

5. Entries will be subjected to a pre-selection process by a Selection Committee appointed by the BVRG Director. Selection committee members are not permitted to enter artworks into the exhibition.

6. Two entries will be chosen as winners. Winners will each receive a \$500 artists fee and have their winning entries reproduced as a large public artwork mural and be placed on a council owned water tank in either Bermagui or Bemboka. The judges' decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into. Location will also be chosen by the judges.

7. Artworks may be photographically reproduced and used for publicity and promotional purposes by the BVRG.

8. Winners will be announced at a function to be held at the Bega Valley Regional Gallery on a date to be confirmed.
