






TOMMY WATSON

Use colours that remind you of where you live to create an abstract* drawing that <i>feels</i> like home




^{*}Abstract art does not try to show the world realistically. Instead shapes, colours, forms and lines are used to achieve its effect.

In Matthew Johnson's colourful and highly pigmented* paintings, he mixes shiny pigments into oil paint to make them glow. In his work Aqua Lacuna (after Gabo) he paints colourful circles onto a grid.

^{*}Pigment is a coloured material (usually a powder) used to colour a liquid like paint, ink etc. If something is highly pigmented, it has a lot of pigment in it.
